

TOP 5 BASS FISHING LAKESIN TEXAS

SAM RAYBURN RESERVOIR

This huge, fertile body of water is a largemouth haven and regarded by many as one of the top bass lakes in the nation. Some local experts believe the first 20-pound fish swims in this water.

1 2 FALCON LAKE

Falcon is considered one of the best largemouth bass lakes in the state. To win a bass tournament at Falcon, it often takes a 5-6 pound average/fish for your stringer.

TOLEDO BEND RESERVOIR

This reservoir straddles the Texas and Louisiana border.

The lake offers a variety of fishing opportunities and is most known for producing trophy largemouth bass.

____LAKE CONROE

Largemouth bass are the most pursued sportfish in the lake. The lake holds a moderate-sized population but has good potential to grow trophy-size bass.

1 S LAKE O' THE PINES

Lake O' the Pines is considered one of the prettiest spots in East Texas. An excellent lake for Largemouth Bass. A combination of dark-colored water and an average depth of 13 feet keep fish close to the surface.
